WHEREAS, the Municipal Governing Body of the City of Oneonta met on this 28th day of August, 2014, a quorum thereof being present at 6:30 AM and has canvassed the returns, and has ascertained and determined the number of votes received by each candidate, and

WHEREAS, the said Municipal Governing Body has ascertained and determined the results of said election as follows:

1. That Steve Anderton received a majority of the votes cast for the office of School Board Place 2 and is hereby declared duly elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday in October, 2014.
 2. That no candidate received a majority of the votes cast for the office of School Board Place No. 4, and that Patrick W. Adams and Russell Smith received the most and second most votes cast for that office. therefore, a runoff election between said candidates is hereby ordered to be held on Tuesday, October 7th, 2014 pursuant to the requirements of Section 11-46-20 et seq., of the Alabama Code of 1975, as amended
