Councilman Blackwood gave the invocation.

Councilman Phillips moved to approve the minutes from May 22, 2018 council meeting as written. Councilman Blackwood seconded and the motion carried with all ayes.

Councilman Butler made a motion to reappoint Kevin Marazzi to the Park and Recreation Board. Councilman Robinson seconded and the motion carried with all ayes.

Councilman Butler made a motion to appoint Donald Bradley to the Park and Recreation Board. Councilman Blackwood seconded and the motion carried with all ayes.

Councilwoman Rogers made a motion to appoint Anna Daniel to the Beautification Board. Councilman Robinson seconded and the motion carried with all ayes.

A representative with the Chamber of Commerce was not present for the meeting.

Marlene Stroud with the Beautification Board exclaimed how great downtown is looking, and stated she welcomes Anna Daniel to the board and is excited for what is to come.

Paul Allred with the Oneonta Business Association thanked the Mayor and City Council for their continued support. Mr. Allred stated June Fling was a true success with the participation of over 100 vendors and a great outcome for local businesses. He left everyone with the Oneonta Business Association motto "Shop Local".

Ed Lowe stated he appreciates Paul Allred emphasizing the importance of shopping local. Ed Lowe requested a capital request on behalf of the Park and Recreation Department for an equipment identification maker. Councilman Phillips made a motion for the capital request purchase of an equipment identification maker. Councilman Butler seconded and the motion carried with all ayes.

Councilman Blackwood thanked all of the new appointments for volunteering their time and stated it excites him to see new and young people engaging with the community.

Councilman Butler congratulated the new appointments and mentioned he has received positive feedback concerning the new gym flooring. Councilman Butler made a motion to set a work session immediately after the June 26<sup>th</sup> regular scheduled council meeting to discuss matters

concerning the park and recreation department. Councilman Blackwood seconded and the motion carried with all ayes.


Councilman Phillips thanked all the newly appointed board members and thanked Anna Daniel for her prior volunteer work before becoming a member of the Beautification Board. Councilman Phillips mentioned there have been several complaints of speeding near the previous 3-way stop intersecting Springville Boulevard and Old Mill Road, and stated the city is looking further into the situation to develop the best solution.


Councilman Robinson read the May statistics on behalf of the Oneonta Public Library and congratulated all the newly appointed board members.
