Councilman Robinson moved to approve the minutes from August 28, 2018 council meeting as written. Councilwoman Rogers seconded and the motion carried with all ayes.

Councilman Blackwood made a motion to approve the minutes from August 28, 2018 work session as written. Councilman Phillips seconded and the motion carried with all ayes.

A public hearing was held on the same date at 5:15 p.m. for the purpose of discussing the vacation of C Street. 
